

## 2014/2015 CCA Parent Survey Results

The results of the recent parent survey are in and they are overwhelmingly positive! Parents were asked to answer the first ten questions of the survey with the following: 5=strongly agree, 4=agree, 3=neutral, 2=disagree, 1=strongly disagree.

Question	Average Response
1. CCA provides a good classroom experience for your student.	4.4 out of 5
2. I am happy to refer CCA to those in my circle of influence.	4.4 out of 5
3. The history and heritage of CCA has been inspirational to my family.	3.9 out of 5
4. CCA programs and/or staff have inspired my family to stretch beyond average.	3.9 out of 5
5. My needs and suggestions are important to CCA leadership.	3.7 out of 5
6. I know who to go to if I have a problem at CCA.	4.3 out of 5
7. I feel comfortable giving feedback to the school and its administration.	4.2 out of 5
8. I understand the future plans and goals for CCA.	4.4 out of 5
9. CCA's future plans are well aligned with the goals and plans of our family.	3.9 out of 5
10. I have confidence in CCA to fix problems, grow as a school, and make improvements each year.	4 out of 5
